DoLS (Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards) Train-the-Trainer Course



Overview

Although DoLS was introduced to safeguard the liberty of those in care, the following of the rules also protects not only the individual client but also the care home and its staff.

Unfortunately it is a fact that some people do need an element of restraint in some form for their own protection, it is sometimes easy to overlook amount of time these restraints are imposed at and at a level which is more than required.
